There was a problem with elephants having to go into hostile areas to drink. The Loke Foundation are looking at a WPT Venturo system to pump water from a river across a range of hills to storage tanks and waterholes where elephants can drink safely.

A Wildlife Park in Kenya is looking at the Venturo Pump to deliver water for elephants which will mean they don't have to travel to waterholes in areas under threat by poachers.
